Why choose BOKASHI ORGANKO?



An average 4-person family produces a large amount of organic waste on daily basis. It represents up to 30% of all household waste.

What is Bokashi?

Bokashi is a mixture of molasses (sugar and water) and natural beneficial microorganisms (lactic acid bacteria, yeast fungus, photosynthetic organisms, actinomycetes and enzyme active fungus) that initiates fermentation process and prevents decay in the BOKASHI ORGANKO composter. After the fermentation process is finished organic waste retains all essential nutrients (especially nitrogen) that would disappear by decay. As a result, fermented organic waste is an excellent basis for first quality compost.

Its decomposition results in:

- unpleasant odour,
- attraction of insects,
- increase of greenhouse gases,
- groundwater pollution.

BOKASHI ORGANKO is a sophisticated and practical composter for organic waste disposal which eliminates inconveniences with collecting organic waste. Waste decay is the most frequent reason for unpleasant odour. **BOKASHI ORGANKO** prevents organic waste from rotting while the addition of Bokashi bran eliminates any unpleasant odours.

What organic waste can be disposed of in BOKASHI ORGANKO?



Almost all organic waste can be put into BOKASHI ORGANKO. We recommend cutting bigger pieces into smaller ones to make the fermentation process easier.

WASTE SUITABLE:

- fruit and vegetables
- prepared foods
- cooked and raw meat
- cheese
- fish
- yoghurt
- eggs
- smaller bones
- bread
- coffee grinds
- tea bags
- wilted flowers and tissues



WASTE NOT SUITABLE:

Liquids:

- vinegar
- juice
- milk
- oil
- water

Other:

- larger bones
- ashes
- animal excrements
- paper



Which are the products of the fermentation process?



FERMENTATION LIQUID

It is produced during the fermentation process and can be used as:

- an excellent fertilizer for garden or pot plants (dilution ratio 1:200);
- drain and septic tank conditioner (undiluted).



An average family uses 1 kg of Bokashi bran in approximately 1 month. Shelf life is one year. It can be used for outdoor composting.

BASIS FOR FIRST QUALITY COMPOST

Presence of natural microorganisms in the Bokashi bran initiates the fermentation process in the bucket. Organic waste retains all essential nutrients, vitamins, and minerals. Pesticides and harmful substances are decomposed into harmless elements. A mixture of fermented organic waste from **BOKASHI ORGANKO** provides an excellent basis for first quality compost suitable for farming.

How is it packed?



BOKASHI ORGANKO – SINGLE

It is suitable for users who will dispose of the contents of the composter in the organic waste container. It is practical for urban areas and houses without a compost pile.



BOKASHI ORGANKO – SET OF TWO COMPOSTERS

For garden and composter owners, owners who want to complete the fermentation process in the BOKASHI ORGANKO. When the first composter is full, the user can continue to collect organic waste in the other composter. When the fermentation process is finished, the contents of the first composter may be dug into soil or put onto a compost pile. It will turn into first quality compost within 3-4 week.

BOKASHI ORGANKO – Set of two composters is packed in carton boxes. The label, declaration and name may be changed. Packaging conforms with Slovenian standards.
